On Monday 23rd April 1989, Blair Peach was killed in Southall, London. The circumstances of his death have been the subject of a public enquiry. This report provides a detailed account of the events leading up to his death, based on the testimonies of those who were present at the time. It details the actions of the police and the anti-apartheid protesters, and the role of the Southall Community Centre in the events. The report also discusses the impact of the death on the anti-apartheid movement and the community in Southall.
